

## 3.12 Trapezoid with Inscribed Circle

Bases of a trapezoid:  $a, b$

Lateral sides:  $c, d$

Midline:  $q$

Altitude:  $h$

Diagonals:  $d_1, d_2$

Angle between the diagonals:  $\varphi$

Radius of inscribed circle:  $r$

Radius of circumscribed circle:  $R$

Perimeter:  $L$

Area:  $S$

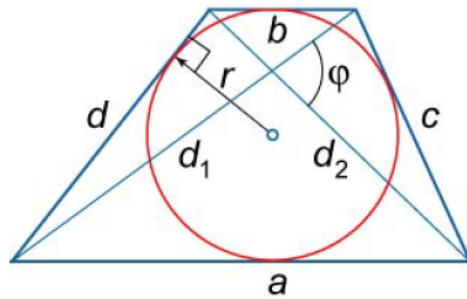

$$230. \quad a + b = c + d$$

$$231. \quad q = \frac{a+b}{2} = \frac{c+d}{2}$$

$$232. \quad L = 2(a+b) = 2(c+d)$$

$$233. \quad S = \frac{a+b}{2} \cdot h = \frac{c+d}{2} \cdot h = qh,$$

$$S = \frac{1}{2} d_1 d_2 \sin \varphi.$$
